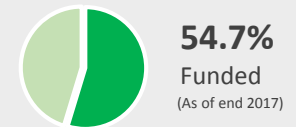
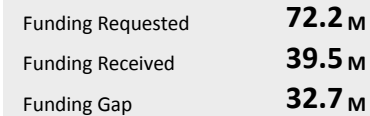
## PROTECTON CLUSTER STRATEGY
