Humanitarian Context

Over the last six months, the intensification of the conflict in Yemen’s western coast has prompted the displacement of 100,000 new IDPs in areas reached by humanitarian partners based in the Aden hub. Since December 2017, displacement has been reported in Abyan, Lahj and Aden governorates, with close to 5,000 families now residing in coastal areas of Taizz and Al Hudaydah.

With an estimated 7,000 migrants entering Yemen each month, most of them seeking to reach Saudi Arabia and other Gulf countries, the United Nations migration agency on Tuesday called for greater efforts to protect them from smugglers and other criminals. Yemen is experiencing the worst humanitarian crisis in the world; it is obviously not a safe route for migrants – UN migration agency.

In Fara Al-Udayn district, the majority of people find it difficult to get enough access to drinkable water since most of the wells are private. The quantity of water people get is less than Sphere minimum standards. Furthermore, people who live in Al-Ahmol village spend more than one hour to reach the main water point for fetching water.

Sana’a Hub: The Shelter/NFI/CCCM Cluster reports that 294 families (approximately 2,000 people) who


were recently displaced from Al Jawf Governorate to Harf Sufyan District in Amran Governorate will receive non-food items and emergency shelter kits as emergency assistance. In Al Bayda Governorate, fighting was reported in Nati’ and Al Qurayshiyah districts. An assessment by a local NGO of 224 recently displaced households found IDPs living in open areas in urgent need of clean drinking water and latrines, shelter, food and education. The district health unit in Nati’, which was damaged in recent fighting, needs to be rehabilitated.

On 12 May, WHO and the Ministry of Public Health and Population launched the second round of the vaccination campaign to combat Diphtheria. The vaccination campaign, which covers the period between 12 May and 17 May, is targeting 2.69 million children from 6 weeks to 15 years of age in 39 prioritized districts and an additional 401,000 children from 6 weeks to 15 years of age in an additional 23 districts-around 3, 361,000 children are now targeted in this round. The second round is expected to complement the first round by providing the targeted children with the second dosage of the vaccine. An estimated 2.7 million children were initially targeted during the 1st round of diphtheria vaccination last March.





DISTRICTS: Fara Al-Udayn - Mudhaikhera - As Sabra

Nutrition:

According to the CMAM program, our targeted health centers (Dhana'a – Musine'ah – Hudhifah) continue providing therapeutic nutritional services for all children under five and pregnant & lactating women, reaching a total number of 1124 beneficiaries in Fara Al-Udayn district, IBB governorate.

Our nutritionists in four targeted health centers (Bani Ali – Halian – Al-Sharqi – Al-Afuash) continue providing therapeutic nutritional services such as Targeted Supplementary Feeding Program (TSFP) for all Children Under five (CU5) and Pregnant & Lactating Women (PLW), reaching a total number of 523 individuals in Mudhiakhera district of Ibb governorate.



Preparation for CMAM Trainings:


Our health & nutrition field teams have done much to prepare for the initiation of “CMAM Refresher Training” targeting 12 health workers (HWs) and also “CMAM Basic Training” for 24 community health volunteers (CHVs) in Mudhiakhera district, Ibb governorate.

Health:

Medical Health Services:

A total number of 3605 beneficiaries continue to receive free medical services through our three targeted health facilities (Dhana'a – Musine'ah – Hudhifah) which we support to provide assistance for those patients of diverse diseases, children, and pregnant & lactating women in reproductive age, living in Fara Al-Udayn district of IBB governorate.

A total number of 2029 individuals continue to receive free medical services including Primary Health Care (PHC), Vaccination, Integrated Management Childhood Illnesses (IMCI), Reproductive Health services (RH) through our four targeted health centers (Bani Ali – Halyan – Al-Sharqi – Al-Afuash) which we support to provide assistance for all patients of diverse diseases, children, and Pregnant & Lactating Women (PLW) in reproductive age, living in Mudhiakhera district of Ibb governorate.



Outreach Activities:

Our nutrition field team has provided door-to-door nutritional services for the most vulnerable groups in Al Ashraf, Al Awtaf and Rewainah areas nearby the three targeted health centers in Fara Al-Udayn district. Those people are affected and live in further reaches as the third catchment areas where it's hard to make it to the health centers.



Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH):

Water Tanks Installation:

Our WASH field team has completed the construction work of water tank base and installed 5 water tanks to benefit 120 (HHs), 840 individuals of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) and affected host communities in Fara Al-Udayn district of Ibb governorate.



Water Quality Test:

Our WASH field team in Fara Al-Udayn district of Ibb governorate, has done – in coordination with Water & Sanitation Corporation – three water tests for three wells (Al-Alimmah – Mohammed Farhan – Abdullah Taher) in order to measure the quality of water and to find out which one matches the high standards of being potable water.



Feasibility Study on Water Resources:

RDP has contracted with a consultant for the conduction of feasibility study on water resources to find out whether the only public well (Al-hasha) in Fara Al-Udayn district can possibly be rehabilitated or not. It's one essential approach to guarantee the achievement of sustainable utilization of water. In the meantime, our WASH team however rented a pump in order to be installed in the aforementioned well.

Wells Rehabilitation study:

In Al-Ahmol area of Fara Al-Udayn district, our field team along with a contracted consultant did a comprehensive rehabilitation study for Al-Hashah well to test its productivity of potable water since it's the only main public well in the area.



Emergency Water Supply:


After the installation of 5 water tanks in Al-Ahmol area, our field team started water provision to benefit 840 individuals in Fara Al-Udayn district.

Hygiene Kits & Jerry Water Cans:

In Fara Al Udayn district, our field team has received 1000 HKs and 2000 Jerry water cans from UNICEF to be distributed for IDPs and vulnerable families with malnourished cases either children or Pregnant & Lactating Women (PLW) in Fara Al-Udayn district.


TAIZZ GOVERNORATE

Total beneficiaries reached: **9,504 Households & 472 Individuals**

DISTRICTS: Ash Shamayatayn - Mawiyah - Shara'b Ar-Rawnah

Nutrition:

According to the CMAM program, our targeted health centers (Adeem Hadharim – Maternity & Childhood) continue providing therapeutic nutritional services for all children under five and pregnant & lactating women, reaching a total number of 472 beneficiaries in Ash Shamayatayn district, Taizz governorate.



Food Security and Livelihoods:

May Distribution of Food Assistance Vouchers in Mawiyah:

Our FSL field members launched May food assistance distribution, reaching a total number of (3125) HHs by using the voucher modality for the most conflict-affected and vulnerable households in six sub-districts (Ghamaera, Esrar, Awujuh, Amaemah, Sharqi Suraq, and Mawmaj) of Mawiyah district, Taizz governorate.



Registration and Verification Workshop:

On May 2nd, 2018, our FSL team conducted a training workshop for the registration and verification teams in Shara'b Ar Rawnah district of Taizz governorate. 32 team members have been trained on the tools of selecting beneficiaries based on well-defined criteria and how to verify the registered names of beneficiaries.

May Distribution of Food Assistance Vouchers in Ash Shamayatayn:

Our FSL team had launched May distribution of food assistance vouchers, reaching a total number of 3157 HHs, 14,713 individuals disaggregated (4107 women, 3938 men, 3142 girls, 3526 boys) by utilizing the voucher modality for the most affected and vulnerable households in four sub-districts (Asabeh, Adeem, Hadharem, and Alzakeria), Ash Shamayatayn district of Taizz governorate.

Conducting the Post Distribution Monitoring (PDM):

Our FSL enumerators have conducted the first PDM activity after the implementation of the first distribution cycle of food baskets, taking samples from 310 houses in (Alasabih, Adeem, and Hadharem) sub-districts of Ash Shamayatayn district and from 283 houses in (Ghamaera, Esrar, Awujuh, Amaemah, Sharqi Suraq, and Mawmaj) sub-districts of Mawiyah district, Taizz governorate.

Protection:

Protection Needs Assessment:

Our protection field team along with 18 enumerators have conducted a Protection Needs Assessment for approximately 222 households as 90% of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) and 10% of affected host community in two sub-districts (Duba'a Al-Dakhel and Assafya'a) of Ash Shamayatayn district, Taizz governorate.



Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH):

Hygiene Kits & Jerry Water Cans:

Our field team has received 3000 HKs and 6000 Jerry water cans from UNICEF to be distributed for most affected families with malnourished cases either children or Pregnant & Lactating Women (PLW) in Ash Shamayatayn district.
