


Cluster Overview

9.3 million people were reached with wash assistance out of an overall caseload of 11.1 million people targeted. Overall, some 4.8 million people were reached with support to public water systems (67 per cent of the target) and 3.6 million people benefited from support to sanitation systems (72 per cent of the target).
