

PASSENGERS TRANSPORT OVERVIEW – AUGUST 2018

DJIBOUTI – ADEN – DJIBOUTI





Background

The Logistics Cluster coordinates and facilitates a weekly passenger movement between Djibouti and Aden on the WFP-chartered vessel, VOS Apollo, which is also used for emergency rescue and evacuation purposes. 
The VOS Apollo has a capacity of 600 mt, therefore it is also used to transport cargo from Djibouti to Aden on behalf of humanitarian organisations when the need arises. Since May 2016, a regular schedule and booking system have been in place, with weekly rotations between Djibouti and Aden. The schedule allows passengers to easily connect with UNHAS flights between Djibouti and Sana'a.

General overview

- 121 rotations with 2,527 passengers transported between Djibouti and Aden on behalf of 42 service users (14 UN agencies, 24 INGOs, 4 NNGOs), for an average rate of use of 46% (maximum capacity 25 passengers per leg/50 per voyage).
- Thanks to the contributions received from DFID, Canada, ECHO, Germany, CERF and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, WFP and the Logistics Cluster will be able to extend the service until the end of 2018.


Total passenger movements PAX # DJI-ADEN PAX # ADEN-DJI → Pax per Voyage Tot pax per vovage March 2018
