### Humanitarian Context:

Fighting has escalated in the eastern and southern areas of Al Hudaydah city, rendering the main road to the capital, Sana’a, inaccessible to humanitarian partners. Civilian casualties have been reported and infrastructure has been damaged. Fighting was also reported in the districts of Bait al Faqih, and At-Tuhayat, particularly in the Al Jah and Jabaliya areas, and in Hays.

Fighting between various groups decreased in Taizz city as parties to the conflict relocated heavy weapons and fighters to frontlines outside the city. However, civilian casualties were reported from landmines and shelling, including two civilians who died when a landmine detonated on the road between Hayfan District and Lahj Governorate.

During the reporting period, armed clashes were reported in Hayfan and Maqbanah districts in

Taizz Governorate, hampering the humanitarian response particularly in Hayfan where there were recurrent clashes and there is landmine contamination. In Ibb Governorate, the situation remained relatively calm.

Taizz, Hajjah, Amanat al Asimah, Ibb and Amran governorates recorded the highest displacement figures – over 25,000 households each – while Aden, Amanat al Asimah and Taizz had the highest number of returns, making them areas of both displacement and return. In Al Hudaydah, over 300,000 people are estimated to have been displaced by the escalated conflict.

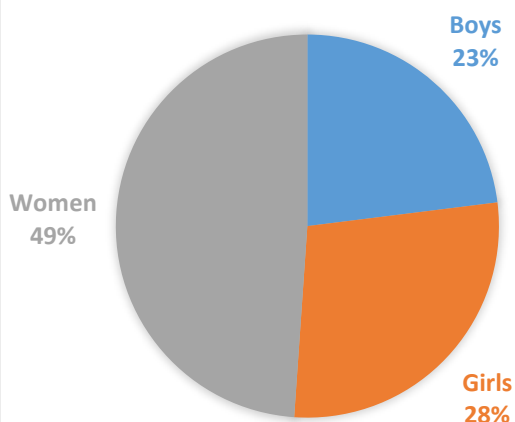
As of 15 September, more than 73,500 displaced households had been registered in Aden, Al Hudaydah, Sana’a, Ibb and Sa’ada hubs, of whom nearly 70,000 of them had received rapid response assistance and non-food items

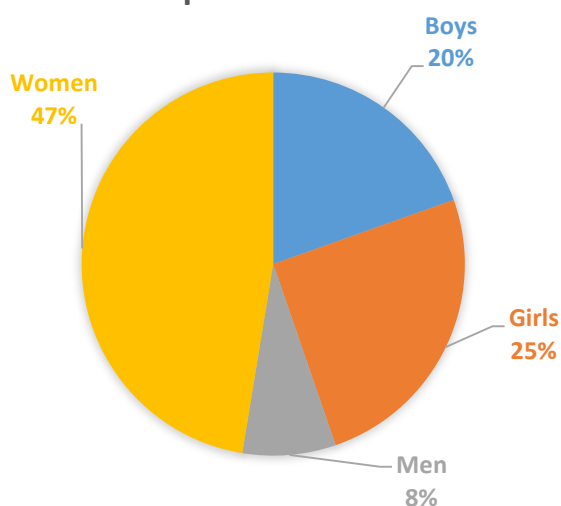

## IBB GOVERNORATE

Total beneficiaries reached: (6,054) individuals

DISTRICTS: Mudhaikhera

### Nutrition:

#### Daily Nutritional Services in Mudhiakhera District:

Our nutritionists in four targeted health centers (Bani Ali – Halian – Al-Sharqi – Al-Afuash) continue providing therapeutic nutritional services such as Targeted Supplementary Feeding Program (TSFP) for all Children Under five (CU5) and Pregnant & Lactating Women (PLW), reaching a total number of (819) individuals disaggregated ( PLW, boys, girls) in Mudhiakhera district of Ibb governorate.



### Health:

#### Daily Health Services in Mudhiakhera District:

A total number of (5,235) individuals disaggregated (men, women, boys, girls) continue to receive free medical services including Primary Health Care (PHC), Vaccination, Integrated Management Childhood Illnesses (IMCI), Reproductive Health services (RH) through four targeted health centers (Bani Ali – Halyan – Al-Sharqi – Al-Afuash) which we support to provide assistance for patients of many diseases, children, and Pregnant & Lactating Women (PLW) in reproductive age, living in Mudhiakhera district of Ibb governorate.





### GHO Observation:

Dr. Omar Al Garhazi, the deputy of nutrition coordinator of Ibb Gov, paid a visit to check up the ongoing work in our four targeted health centers (Bani Ali – Halyan – Al-Sharqi – Al-Afuash) in Mudhiakhera district, Ibb governorate.

### MoPIC Observation:

Eng. Taher Al Garmozzi, the deputy manager of Ministry of Planning and International Cooperation (MoPIC) in Ibb Governorate, conducted field visit to Halyan health unit to observe the services provided and match the ministry standards.



### Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH):

#### WASH Needs Assessment Survey in Mudhiakhera Dist:

We have trained 15 enumerators on how to collect beneficiaries' data by using Kobo tool in order to conduct WASH survey. The trained enumerators have covered 30 locations in Mudhiakhera Dist. of Ibb Governorate, reaching a total number of 204 surveys (105 host HHs/99 IDPs HHs).



#### Closure of the Emergency WASH Project in Fara Al-Udayn Dist:

From March 1<sup>st</sup> to August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018, the Emergency WASH Project was funded by Sign of Hope e.V. which was aimed to alleviate the suffering of IDPs and affected host communities through daily water provision, reaching a total number of 1,954 individuals in Al-Ahmol sub-district of Fara Al-Udayn Dist.

#### Closure of Hygiene Kits Distribution Project in Fara Al-Udayn Dist:

From March 1<sup>st</sup> to August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018, the activity of hygiene kits distribution was funded by Sign of Hope e.V. which aimed to alleviate the suffering of IDPs and affected host communities, reaching a total number of 2,840 individuals in Al-Ahmol sub-district of Fara Al-Udayn Dist.

## Taizz Governorate

DISTRICTS: Ash Shamayatayn - Mawiyah - Shara'b Ar-Rawnah.

### Nutrition:

#### Closure of the Emergency Nutrition and Food Security Project in Ash Shamayatayn Dist:

From December 1st, 2017 to August 30th, 2018, RDP provided therapeutic nutritional services for all children under five and pregnant & lactating women within the Emergency Nutrition and Food Security project, reaching a total number of 7556 individuals disaggregated (3976 women, 1811 boys, 1769 girls).

### Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH):

#### WASH Needs Assessment Survey:

We have trained 12 enumerators on how to collect beneficiaries' data by using Kobo tool in order to conduct WASH survey. The trained enumerators have covered 78 locations in Ash Shamayatayn Dist. of Taizz Governorate, reaching a total number of 209 (106 host HHs/103 IDPs HHs).

### Food Security and Livelihoods:

**Second Post Distribution Monitoring (PDM) Survey in Shara'b Ar Rawnah District:** Our FSL enumerators have launched the second PDM activity

right after the implementation of the second distribution cycle of food baskets in order to determine whether the first distribution cycle of food baskets progressed or not, and to measure its effectiveness and impact on the recipient population by taking samples from 10% of the overall HHs in (Sharqi Hamir, Bani Samie'a, Aleawadir, Bani Murir (Qubair), Hasiat Alhajj (Alsharqia)) sub-districts of Shara'b Ar Rawnah district, Taizz governorate.

#### Closure of the Emergency Food Assistance to the most Affected and Vulnerable Households Project in Ash Shamayatayn Dist.

From December 1st, 2017 to August 30th, 2018, RDP launched three distribution cycles of food assistance vouchers within the Emergency Food Assistance to the most Affected and Vulnerable Households project, reaching a total number of 3157 HHs, 14,713 individuals disaggregated (4107 women, 3938 men, 3142 girls, 3526 boys).

#### Closure of the Emergency Nutrition and Food Security Project in Mawiyah Dist.

From December 1st, 2017 to August 30th, 2018, RDP launched three distribution cycles of food assistance vouchers within the Emergency Nutrition and Food Security project, reaching a total number of 3125 HHs, 21875 individuals disaggregated (8750 men, 9100 women, 1969 boys, 2056 girls).
